Blessed with crystal clear skies in March, and an ideal location, the Northwest Territories has been proven to be one of the top three destinations in the world to view the Aurora dance.



Why view the Aurora during the Equinox?

The alignment of electrical pathways that happens when the sun crosses the celestial equator makes the Northern Lights activity more frequent and intense.



ITINERARY

March 18

Upon arrival into Yellowknife meet your driver and transfer to the Explorer Hotel for check in.

This afternoon meet the group in the lobby and enjoy an afternoon visit to the legislature and visitors center followed by a Welcome Dinner.

March 19

This morning enjoy a Yellowknife City Tour.

This afternoon embark on a 2 hour snowshoeing tour .

Later this evening head to the lakeside cabin to enjoy your first night viewing of the Aurora.

March 20

Enjoy a later start and enjoy an afternoon dog sledding tour and drive down the ice road to Dettah, a local First Nations community.

Tonight enjoy your second evening of viewing the Northern Lights

March 21

Another restful morning followed by an afternoon Bison Tour. Guests will drive approx 60-90 min to the Tliche community of Behchoko where wild bison roam in the winter.

Tonight enjoy your last prime Equinox viewing of the Aurora.

March 22

This afternoon enjoy a nature tour using your lakeside cabin as a base. Explore by snowhoe searching for the Ptarmigan and other local wildlife.

This evening enjoy a Farewell Dinner with the group sharing stories and photos of a memorable few days.

On your final day enjoy an afternoon ice fishing tour with a local aboriginal including lunch.

Following check out, transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
